He was dressed in pyjamas, his eyes fixed on the television with the volume turned up to an extreme. It was evident that he was using this as a means to cope with the trauma he had endured. Mason had been deemed 'non-verbal' and was not attending school.

The weight of his traumatic experiences had silenced him, leaving him isolated and struggling to communicate his pain.

However, CatholicCare Victoria's dedicated worker, Sally*, saw a glimmer of hope.

She recognised that behind Mason's silence was a voice longing to be heard. With unwavering determination, Sally embarked on a journey to give Mason the voice he so rightfully deserved.

Through compassionate care and tailored support, Sally began to unlock Mason's potential. She provided him with the skills and encouragement to express himself, slowly but surely, breaking through the barriers that had confined him for so long.

As Mason's story illustrates, there is hope even in the darkest of circumstances. With the right support and intervention, we can empower children like Mason to overcome their trauma and help them to reclaim their voices.
