Support for people with complex needs

The Community Connections outreach service provides advocacy support and referrals to essential health and social services.

If you are experiencing housing stress, or do not have secure accomodation, we are here to help you.

- · Are you homeless or at risk of homelessness?
- Is your tenancy at risk and do you need help finding accommodation?
- Do you need assistance with accessing other health and community services?
- · Are you between ages 18 to 64?

A Community Connections Case Manager can work with you and advocate on your behalf by:

- Assisting you with referrals to housing services e.g. public housing, supported residential services, and community or cooperative housing organisations.
- Assisting you with completion of housing application forms, including the Victorian Housing Register.
- Supporting you with sourcing short and long-term accommodation.

A Community Connections Case Manager can also:

- Identify unmet social, health, financial and emotional needs, and help you to access health and community services, to assist with personal care and ongoing supports.
- Link you to services that assist with daily living activities including health and disability providers, and participation in social activities.
- Arrange referrals to other appropriate and specialist services e.g. financial and legal services.



We can advocate and refer you to specialist services that suit your specific needs.
