

Telehealth IQ Testing

WHAT IS IT?

A telehealth session (also known as 'tele practice' or 'telemedicine') includes an examiner and student in different geographical locations. Using a secure software platform (Zoom or MS Teams), an Educational Psychologist and student join a shared web-based meeting, via laptop or phone, with audio and video capability.

Tests take approximately two hours. It can be completed during school hours or special arrangements can be made for after-school hours.

FOR STUDENTS WHO:

- Have learning disabilities
- Are gifted
- Require a special education placement
- Have developmental delays
- Have attention and behavioural issues
- Experience emotional or social challenges

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Highly trained Educational Psychologist conducts and reviews all IQ tests
- Reports completed within approximately two weeks, with recommendations
- A teacher or school counsellor may be required to join the meeting.
