



Child Safe Training | Frequently Asked Questions

Who should attend the training?

A Child Safe and Child Friendly culture is one in which awareness is maximised and risk minimised. As champions of this culture, all parish staff and volunteers, leaders, Priests and Deacons should attend the Child Safe Environment training sessions.

Please note that all Priests and Deacons must attend a training session.

I've already attended Child Safe Environment training as part of my involvement in a Catholic school; do I need to attend this training?

Whilst this training is consistent with training offered by the Catholic Education Office, the Diocese of Sale training has been developed to address the parish context. Therefore, it is recommended that you attend.

How many participants from our parish should attend?

Do all our parish representatives need to attend the same session?

Attendees from the same parish do not need to attend the same session; there are a range of sessions to choose from at locations throughout the Diocese of Sale.
